Major Davis is to complete a CAPF 79 IAW CAPR 62-2. This appointment is in response to a Mishap Report identified as PCR-CA-FY11-2783 dated 07 April 2011 on the Safety Form Online System.
4. Lt Col Kenneth W. Gonzalez, 245154, is appointed to investigate the circumstances surrounding the discovery of a bald tire on Cessna C-182, N877CP, two days after the aircraft had been flown on a SAREX and complete a CAPF 79 IAW CAPR 62-2. This appointment is in response to a Mishap Report identified as PCR-CA-11-2787, dated 08 April 2011 on the Safety Form Online System.
5. Lt Col John R. Aylesworth, 142761, is appointed to investigate the circumstances surrounding the injury to the finger of a cadet which occurred as he was arriving at a Civil Air Patrol event and complete a CAPF 79 IAW CAPR 62-2. This appointment is in response to a Mishap Report identified as PCR-CA-FY11-2795, dated 11 April 2011 on the Safety Form Online System.
