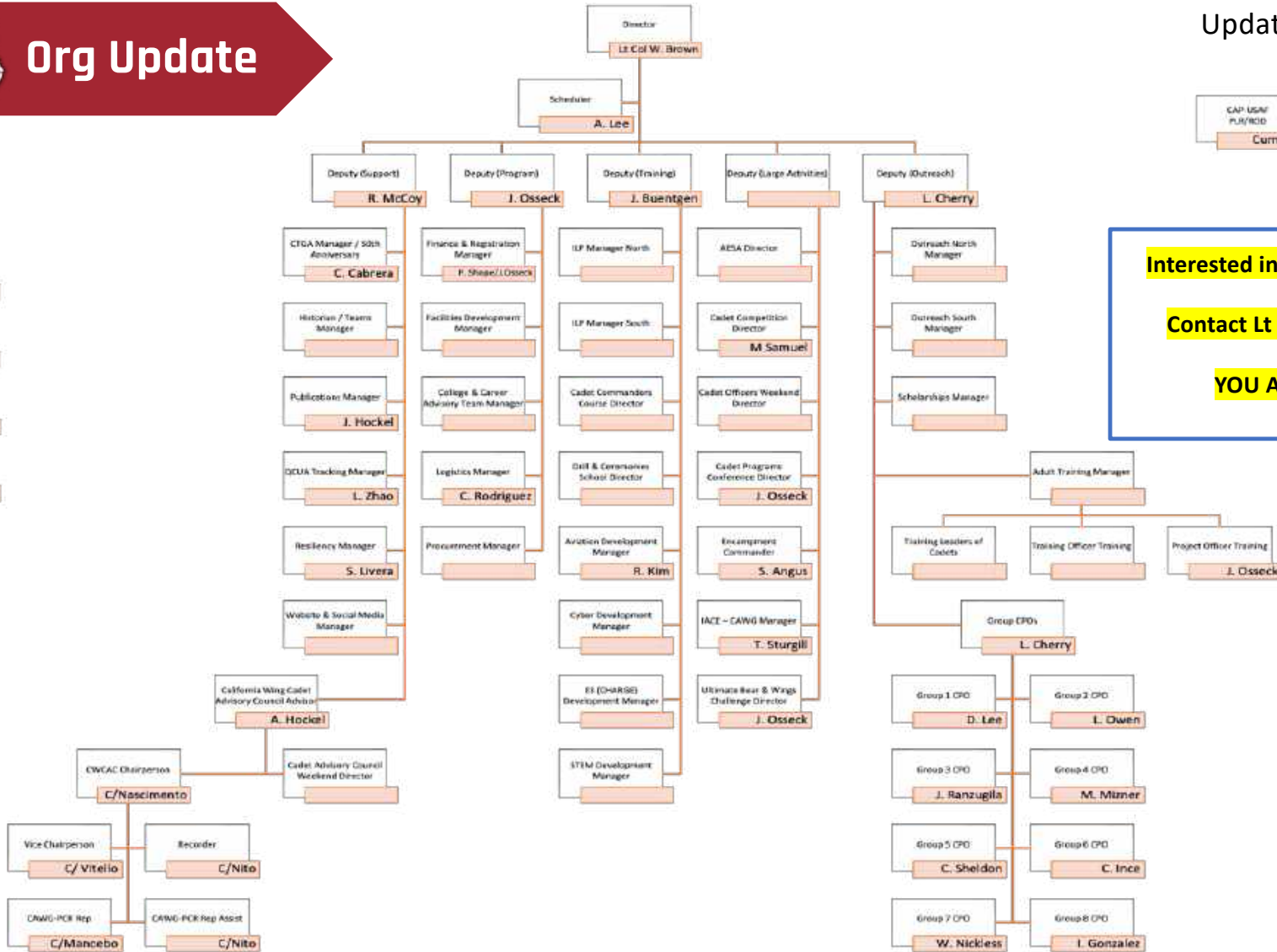

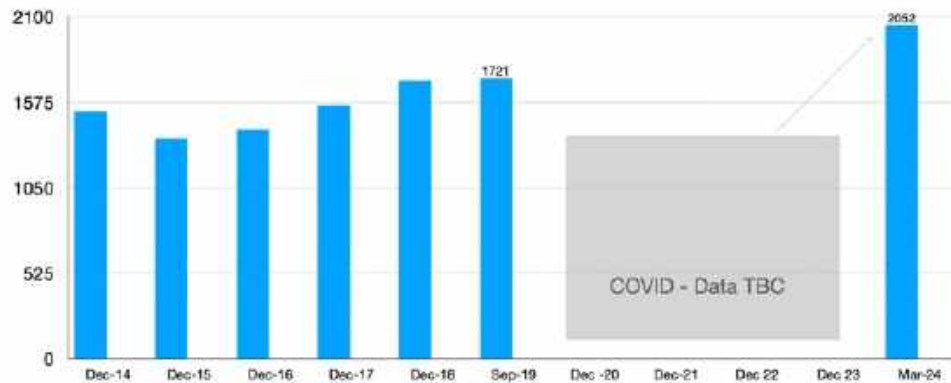

- Detailed by Squadron Report available after this meeting



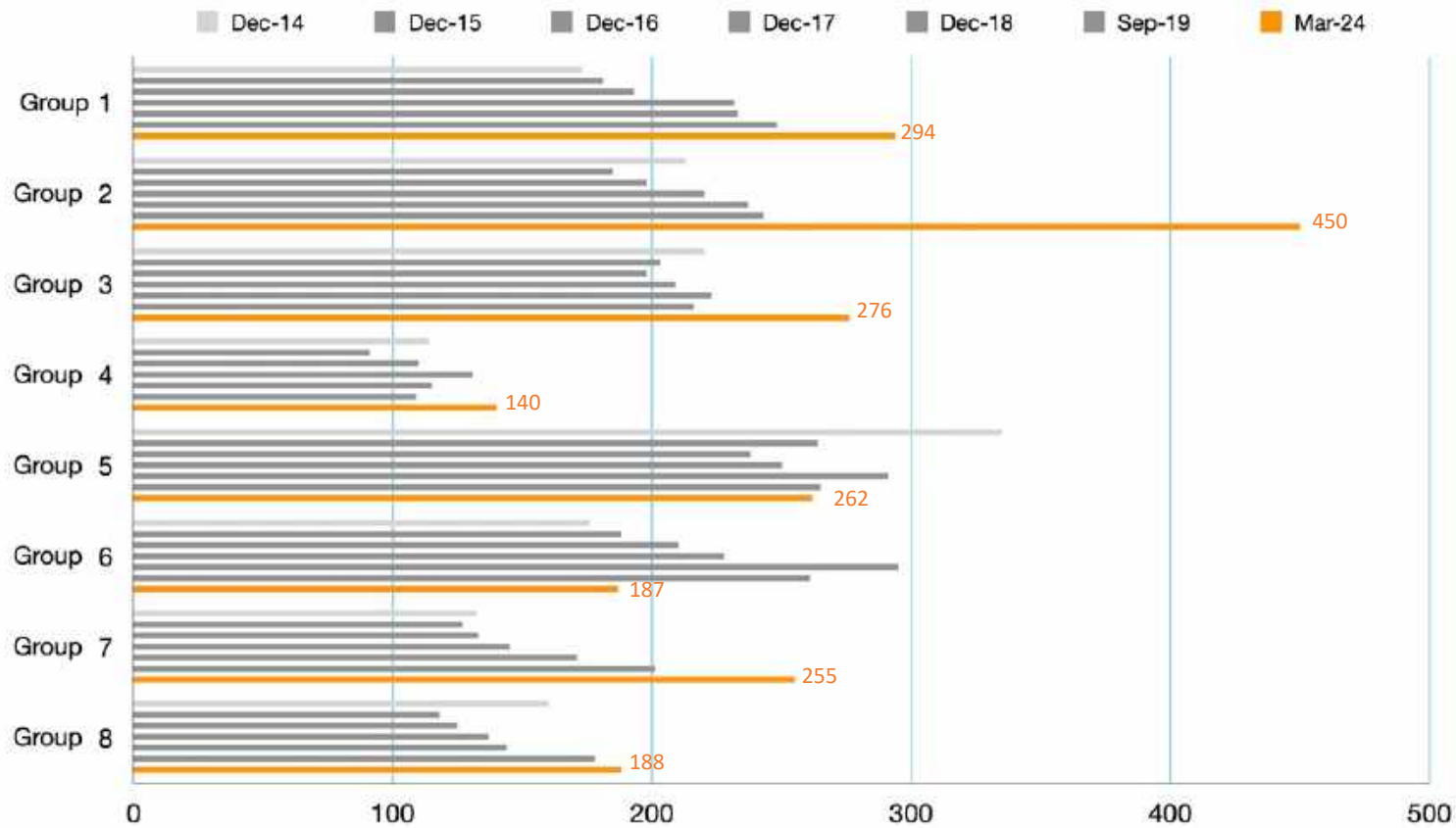

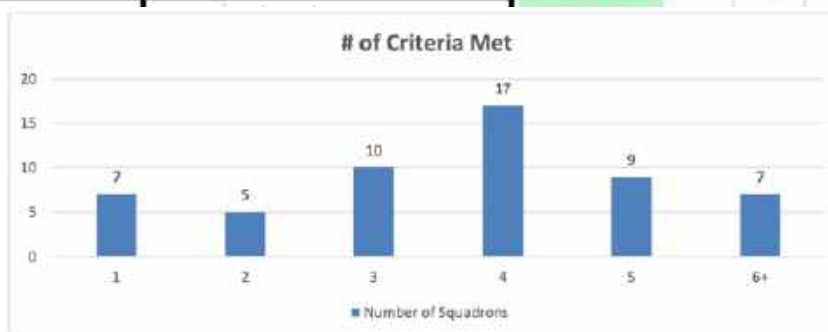

 - Track and Monitor Cadet Protection standards within the Squadrons
