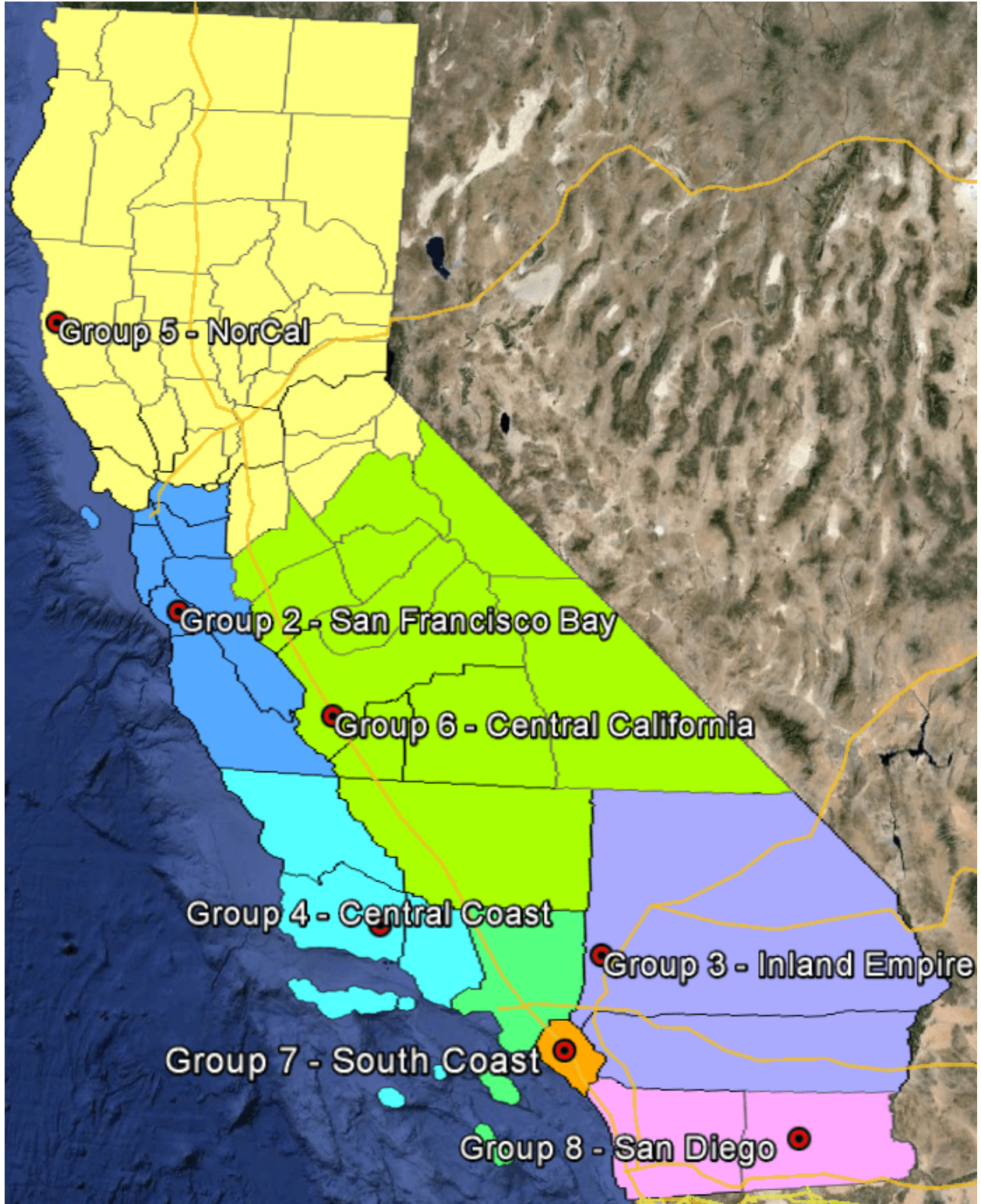




## **FORWARD**

# CHAPTER I – INTRODUCTION

The California Wing of the Civil Air Patrol has the area of responsibility over the Golden State. Within the operational boundaries the Wing operates over 155,779 square miles of land and 7916 square miles of water ways.<sup>1</sup> The Wing serves about 40 million people and since 1941, has executed the three missions of Civil Air Patrol: Aerospace Education, Cadet Programs, and Emergency Services.

**Early History**

The day after the attack on Pearl Harbor the san Francisco Bay Area was awaiting news from the Office of Civil Defense for the establish of a Civil Air Patrol unit(s).<sup>3</sup> However, by March 1942,

400 civilians had applied for the program.<sup>4</sup> During the days of the war, civilians were allowed to train using radio-telephones<sup>5</sup>, first aid, and with civilian law enforcement.<sup>6</sup> The Civil Air Patrol at this time made steps and made sure that it was open to women as well.<sup>7</sup> However, not everyone saw the Civil Air Patrol as a good thing but more of a nuisance.<sup>8</sup> Towards the end of the war the Civil Air Patrol and its counterpart the Coast Guard Auxiliary have called the modern Minute Men.<sup>9</sup> After the United States Air Force (USAF) was created, President Truman signed Public Law 80-557 to make CAP the official auxiliary of the Air Force on May 26, 1948.

## 1950s - 1990s

The CAWG and the Civil Air Patrol as a whole had to make transitions after the war had ended. In 1950, it was reported that the Wing had 8000 cadets.<sup>10</sup> The organization had still provided air search and rescue missions and training cadets.<sup>11</sup> In 1956, the Air Force Secretary stated that the

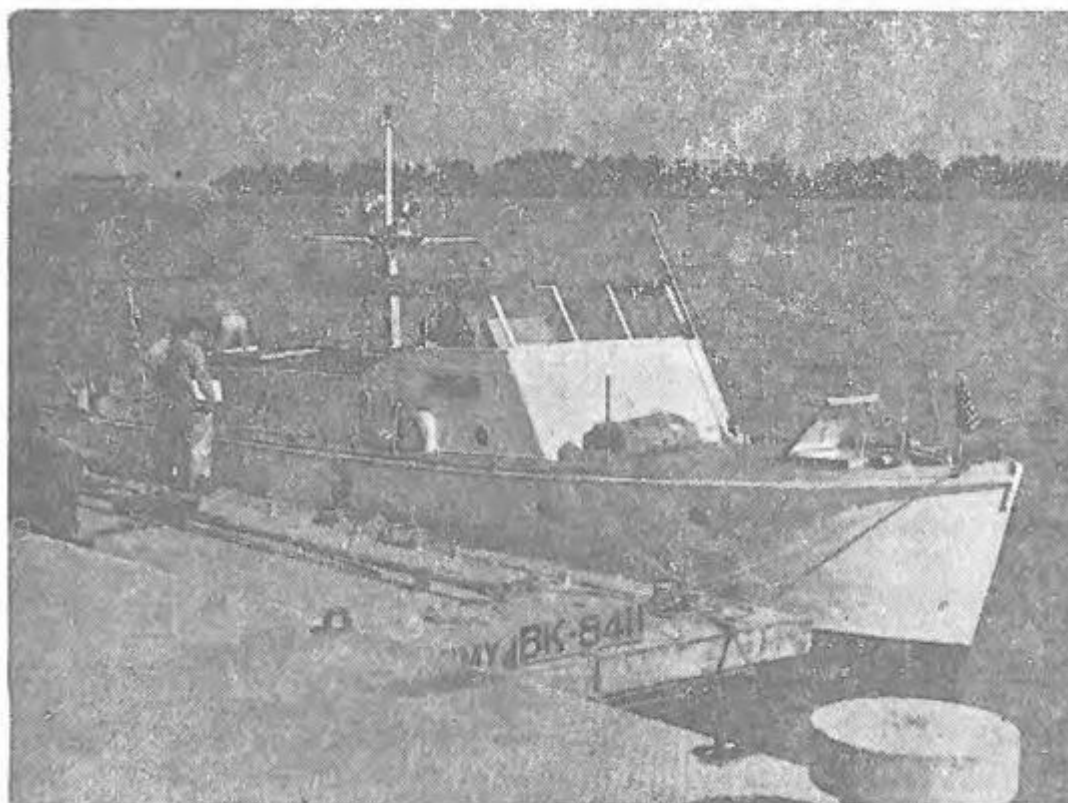

CAP cadet program was a key part and the American public still did not understand that well.<sup>12</sup> In the 1950s, Group 2 had a sea vessel at their disposal. Through the 1960s and the first half of the 1970s the organization started to struggle. The Vietnam War made military based organization unpopular as a result participation such as CAP saw decline in cadet participation. However, the CAWG continued to show promise. The Wing had members participate in a news reel for the Air Force called Air Force Now in 1983. In 1986, NORAD praised the Wing for its support and its communications system. In 1989, CAP CAWG crews went to Alaska to help with the Exxon Valdez oil spill. He 1990s, was a decade of different celebrations and activities. In 1990, the Wing celebrated the 300<sup>th</sup> CAPLOT missions as well as 50 years of existence in 1991. In 1994, the Wing helped respond to the Northridge Earthquake.

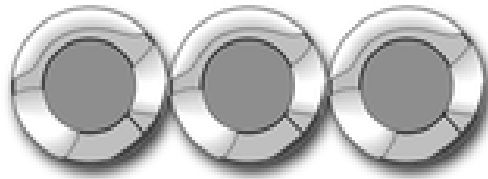

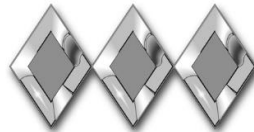
